
The purpose of this letter is to provide the status of the above referenced Local Hazard Mitigation Plan, pursuant to the requirements of 44 CFR Part 201 - Mitigation Planning and the Local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Planning Guidance. The attached Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Review Crosswalk documents the Region's review and compliance with all required elements of 44 CFR Part 201.6, as well as documents local jurisdiction participation in the plan. FEMA's approval will be for a period of five years effective starting the date of this letter.

Prior to the expiration of the plan the community will be required to review and revise its plan to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and resubmit it for approval in order to continue to be eligible for mitigation project grant funding.
